

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

REPORT FOR 1981-82

The college re-opened after summer vacation on 1st July, 1981.

Admissions : As usual, the number of applications for exceeded the number of seats. For various courses under B. Sc. 180 applications were received as against the authorised intake of 128. 150 students were admitted. For the first year B. Com 108 applications were received as against 60 seats available 62 students were admitted. At the M.Sc level, admissions were made by the University. 16 students were allotted to our college while the approved strength was 12. The excess admissions made namely 22 students in the B. Sc. course and 2 students in the B. Com. course were done only after getting prior approval of the University for taking additional students in the current year only.

The reservation rules were strictly followed: 50% for backward classes 18% for scheduled castes/tribes leaving only less than the third of the seats to be filled under open competition

Staff : Appoint of staff has to be made from the list supplied by the employment exchange, following the communal reservation rules.

Further, the appointment should be made for the academic year only or till a teacher rendered surplus in some college is made available to us under the redeployment scheme. As a result of these restrictions, 3 vacancies in the Physics department remained unfilled. One vacancy in the Chemistry department could not be filled.

In the Zoology department, Mr. A J A. Ranjit Singh, M.Sc. I class, M.Phil. I class was appointed on 16th October, 1981. His salary could not be paid for several months as approval of the appointment was received only seven months later. The arrears of salary due to him were claimed after that and paid to him.

In the Mathematics department, Mr. S. Subramanian who was on study leave on loss of pay rejoined duty on 7-1-82 after finishing his Ph.D programme. The substitute appointed in his place was retained till the end of the academic

year on a part-time basis with the approval of the President in order to minimise dislocation in the department

Mr. G. Devarajan, Chemistry and Mr. M. Rajamani, Commerce were permitted to continue their Ph. D programme at Karaikudi and Madras respectively. Mr. M. Palaniswamy, Tamil was deputed with effect from 5-10-1981 to do M. Phil. at Madurai Kamaraj University. The department's approval for the deputation was not received till the end of the year and his salary could not be claimed. However, the Management paid him an advance of Rs. 600/- per month to enable him to complete his study programme

Sports : Our boys won the zonal finals for the second consecutive year in table-tennis. In ball-badminton, our team were runner-up at the finals. It may be noted that in the previous year we were winners.

NCC : The NCC in the college consists of one officer, Lt. J. S. Francis and 110 cadets. Three of the cadets reached the grade of Under Officer during the year. Two of our cadets accompanied by the NCC Officer attended the army attachment camp at Madras Regimental Centre, Wellington for 30 days in June, 1981. 33 cadets attended the Battalion Annual Training camp at Madurai in July, 1981.

40 cadets led by the NCC Officer undertook a cycle tour sponsored by the NCC Directorate. They covered a distance of 400 kilo metres visiting places of educational interest on the way.

The NCC Officer and 90 cadets went to Sivanthipatti firing range near Palayamkottai in February, 1982 for practice in firing both rifles and light machine gun.

35 cadets were sent for the B certificate examination and of them 26 were successful. 3 cadets passed the tough C certificate examination out of 5 that appeared.

NSS : Two units were functioning with a strength of 100 students each. One unit participated in the ecological development programme by camping at Gatana Dam for 10 days and did much useful work. The members of another unit participated in a similar camp at Kodaikhanal and earned high praise for their work from the official visitors.

Adult Education Programme : The National Adult Education Programme (NAEP) unit of the college has established 10 centres in nearby areas for conducting their programmes, 8 centres for scheduled castes and 1 centre exclusively for women. The response has been good. In some centres the participants in a period of six months reached upto third standard level in reading.

Remedial Courses : Remedial courses were conducted by the Zoology and Commerce departments for schedule caste students. We hope to get a grant from the Government for this.

Respected Principal, dear colleagues and ardent volunteers,

I have great pleasure in presenting to you the annual report of the Social Service League for the year 1982-83.

Our programmes are designed mainly to divert students fissiparous tendencies by putting them on to some constructive activities particularly in our campus and incidently teaching them the dignity of labour and to bring some tangible benefits to the college in the form of cleanliness and discipline. Also to inculcate in the youngsters a spirit of social commitment various community study programmes were arranged.

We have inagurated our activity with a selected band of fifty volunteers with the aim "Make our campus clean".

We had rendered our services at the college premises in various forms. Our volunteers periodically cleaned the college campus, watered the plants, groomed the lawns and beautified the gardens. To erode the tendency of fellow students in defacing the walls of the class rooms, our volunteers erased the wall scribblings during Noon-meal break.

We made a thorough survey on the disabled persons of Alwarkurichi and a study was made on their socio-economic status. We had explained the various rehabilitation programmes awaiting for this less fortunate fellow beings. Our survey results are to be published soon. Our servicers had accompanied the volunteers of N. S. S. Unit 129 in cleaning the Mupudathyamman Temple.

The climax of our activity was the visit to the "School for the Visual Handicapped" at Palayamcottah on 13-3-1983. With compassion our volunteers mingled with the blind and for a couple of hours, the blind have forgotton their deformity. As a token of compassion we had contributed a sum of Rupees Eighty two to two outstanding students.

Also we had stretched out our hands in arranging the infrastructure facilities for the various functions held in our campus

We are thankful to our Principal for his magnanimous patronage and incessant encouragement to make our service a constructive one. Also I record my sincere thanks to Prof V. T. Subbiah Asst. Profs Messers L. M. Narayanan, K. R. Paramasivan and Librarian Mr. S. Suriyanarayanan for their valuable guidance.

I have great pleasure in presenting before you a brief report on the activities of NAEPO of our college during 1982-83.

Literacy rate of a nation and its prosperity go hand in hand with each other. It is more so in a democratic country. The very democratic spirit can survive only if the vast majority of the people are literates. Despite all good efforts taken by the Government of India, the literacy rate in India has not risen above 40 %. So this massive programme with huge investment of Rs 600 crores was launched in 1978. The Government is particular that students must be involved in this important task because tomorrow's India is in their hands.

In our college the programme was launched in September '79, we have entered the 4th phase during 1982-83. As in previous years, our students instructors have rendered commendable service in this year also.

The total number of learners enrolled was 210. Eight of the centres were exclusively run for SCs. Though the Government opened centres in our area this year and provided more facilities, our students could also attract more learners with the help of their sincere and whole hearted involvement. Unlike other co-curricular activities, this programme takes up a good portion of instructors' precious time during night time. In spite of this our instructors rendered commendable service under the able supervision of our part time supervisor, Mr. V. Kalyana Sundaram. In all the centres the learners have learnt to write their names. In

some centres the learners are reading Newspaper headlines. All the welfare measures like bank loans, legal aid, subsidies to digging wells, buying cows, rehabilitation to disabled etc., announced by the Government then and there have been communicated to the villagers. This year our instructors were instructed to identify the learners who easily pick up and to prepare them to appear for the first examination under Open University System. Two or three learners are being prepared for that



This year also our instructors prepared many teaching models. The clock model prepared by one Mr S. Ashokkumar, II B Com was appreciated by all. On March 13, NAEP instructors along with S S L volunteers went on a one day tour to Blind school, Palayamkottai, Krishnapuram, Panchalankurichi, SPIC and Tiruchendur.

Since we received only Rs 5000/- as grant from the UGC against the announced amount of Rs 14000/- per annum we could run the centres only for 6 months. In January this year we also received a grant of Rs. 4000/- to take up post literacy and follow up programme. Since we received the grant late, we could not take it up this year. We have proposed to take up the post literacy and follow up work in the next academic year and for that we intend taking active support from NSS, SSL and Rotract Club.
