

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
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
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“THE R.D. CAMP — A PHOBIA TO A MANIA!!”

Life is dull, without thrill and adventure. The College provides a Part V Subject for this purpose. I joined N.C.C. to know that excitement. Now I have got a great feedback. In 25 years of N.C.C. in our college, I'm the first person to go to Delhi for Republic Day Camp (R D C.-'97). I was the only boy from our batallion (5(TN)NCC) at Tirunelveli.

Cadets from other groups like Trichy, Coimbatore, Pondicherry, Madras A & B took part. The contingent comprised of 104 Cadets lead by contingent Commander, Major. S.R.B. Nair and trained by Chief Training Officer Colonel K Venugopalan Commander of Madurai Group.

During the training tenure lot of Physical exertion was required. We had our Drill with arms. I still fear that rifle about Six Kg. weight. Apart from strenuous trainings in daytime, we also had sleepless nights, practising for cultural competitions. All such efforts were needed to win the P.M's banner at R.D.C.-Delhi. Competitions like Drill, Singing, Dancing, Running, Yatching, Aeromodelling, Ship-modeling etc were held. Tamil Nadu

was able to come only as Runners-up. Can you imagine 16 Directorates competing in that prestigious event R.D.C -'97, It was really nice to be like a family for nearly two months. We had golden chances of visiting V.I.P's like the chiefs of Army, Navy and Airforce Staffs and even the Rashtrapathi Bhawan. We had a trip to Agra to observe that Marble-wonder-Taj. Our eyes did not miss the Red-Fort, Lotus Temple, Birla Mandir, Qutib Minar, Indira Memorial, Teen-Murti Bhawan etc.

The special feature of R.D.C -'97 was, that I marched in the National contingent of N.C.C. at the Rajpath on 26th Jan 97 before our President Dr. S. D Sharma. I also proudly saluted our P.M. Mr. H. D. Deve Gowda in the P.M Rally on 27th Jan. '97. I was in my ecstasy when I saw my parents who came for witnessing the R.D. Parade at Delhi. Surprisingly I am chosen for training at Indian Military Academy Dehradun. If I pass this stage successfully I may have better prospects. I also request my fellow students to have a try at it. Since our Army faces 12,000 officers shortage, selection would be rather simple.



On Febraury 13, 1997 all the students of our class (III B Sc. chemistry) went to Dharani Sugars near Vasudevanallur. As preplanned all the students gathered at Tenkasi at 8-30 a.m, and from there went to Dharani Sugars along with our Professors Sri S Ponnusamy and Sri. S. Selvaraj



It was a wonderful sight to see the production of Sugar with the help of sophisticated machinaries.

Sugarcanes are first weighed and then put into endless belts where they undergo dry crushing. The crushed juice is collected in containers where the molasses

are used for steam boiling and for the preparation of alcohol.

The juice collected in big containers are steam boiled and evaporated. Calcium oxide (quick lime) is added for defeacation of juice. The impuritles are removed by adding sulphur dioxide and now the pure sugar juice is recrystalliced to form sugar Crystals. Then they are filled in bags; weighed and sent for sales

A demonstrator explained each process to us in a easy way. It was a happy and interesting experience to learn the things practically

Meanwhile all the tour party went to Thalanai falls and had a good meal. With heart filled with happiness and the reluctance to disperse we returned home

Annual Report 1996-1997

The College reopened on 19-06-96 after the summer vacation for all classes except first year post graduate Classes.

The First year P G Classes were started on 26-08-96 due to the late publication of the results of undergraduate courses by the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University and as a consequence admissions were made late. The college opted for day order system with five working days a week and 90 working days a semester. The college was able to function for the required number of contact days, besides minor disturbances.

Admissions :

As usual the number of applications far exceeded the number of seats in various UG and PG courses. Special permission was therefore obtained from the university to make additional admissions to various UG and PG courses. The permission was granted for the year

Admissions to various courses were strictly made in accordance with the G. O. on communal reservations. There was a depletion of strength later, as students admitted in the first year left the college to join various professional courses and polytechnics. The vacancies that arose after the last date for admission could not be filled up. The total strength of the college now is 780.

We have the evening college courses for B. Sc. Physics and B.Com. The strength of B.Sc., is 60 and the strength in B. Com. is 92.

Non-Teaching Staff : Thiru C. Subramanian, Junior Assistant retired on Superannuation on the afternoon of 28-02-97.

National Cadet Corps: The present strength is 90. Our cadets participated in many camps S. Vijaya Babu. of Second Year B. Sc., Mathematics Major brought Laurels to our institution by participating in Republic day parade at Delhi on 26-01-1997.

Physical Education : Our boys took keen interest and took part in all sports and games conducted by the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. They have excelled and made a mark in games like Ball Badminton, Cricket, Kabadi and in Athletics. For the seventh consecutive year the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University Ball Badminton team was represented by our students. The credit was brought to us by our student M. Lakshminarayana-Moorthy of II M Sc, Chemistry and Ramesh Kannan of third year B. Sc., Zoology Major.

National Service Scheme : There are two units of N S S in our college with Dr. L. M. Narayanan in charge of Unit 19 and Mr. A. Sisubalan is in charge of Unit 18. The total strength of two units is 200.

Faculty Improvement Programme : Mr. P. Manickam M.Com, M.Phil. was deputed for one year Ph. D at Madurai Kamaraj University and was relieved on the afternoon of 22-12-95. Mr. S. Francis was appointed as substitute in the place of Mr. P. Manickam with effect from 26-12-95. Mr. P. Manickam joined after completion of one year Ph. D programme at Madurai Kamaraj University on 20-12-1996.

College Union : The staff council decided to abolish the College Union Election and instead of that the top rankers from various departments were appointed as class representatives.

University Grants Commission : The University Grants Commission sanctioned Rs. 7,00,000 (Seven Lakhs) for the vocationalisation at the First degree level. We now offer Industrial Microbiology as an optional subject for B. Sc Zoology Major students. The strength in this course is 24.

Mr. G. Alagumuthu, M. Sc, M. Phil., Senior Scale Lecturer in Chemistry has been sanctioned Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) for Minor research project.





ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR - 1996 - 1997

A Activities Outside the Campus

I 10-Day Special Camp :

The N S S UNIT No.19 has organised a 10-Day Child Labour Apolition Awareness Research Camp from 05-07 96 to 14-07 96 at Valliammalpuram. A team of 45 volunteers consisting of 33 girls, 3 local girls, 2 social workers and 7 camp officers stayed in Thirumurugan High School for ten days and served in Valliammalpuram and surrounding villages via, Vadamalai patty, Pandarakulam, Kavoor and A. P. Nadanoor of Kadayam Panchayat Union.

It is found out that female child labourers (112) are 17 times higher than male child labourers. This reveals the exploitation of the female children in a worse manner in the chosen villages.

Other findings

1. The prevalence of child labour is highest in the age-group 11 - 14 years
2. Poverty, unwillingness to study, lack of transport and irregular/immoral behaviour of parents are some of the causes of Child Labour
3. Beedi Rolling is the dominant child labour.

Outcome

The N S S volunteers have readmitted 11 drop outs in their respective schools by arranging finance from Lion's Club, Kadayam and local voluntary organisation.

II Biomass Assessment Study Under National Programme

The N S S students conducted a survey on Biomass assessment in collaboration with the school of Energy Sciences, Madurai Kamaraj University in an around Alwarkurichi covering 24 villages.

III National Polio Immunisation

Our N S S volunteers assisted the staff of Primary Health Centre Kadayam and Alankulam in the National pulse and Polio, Immunisation programme on 18-01-'97. 211 Chi/dren including 73 mobile population got immunized. Our N S S volunteers the students of Gandhi Primary School and Chatram Bharathi Girls High School played a dominant roll by organising common programme, Human Chain with the public on 18-01-97 at Kelaiya pillaiyoor.
