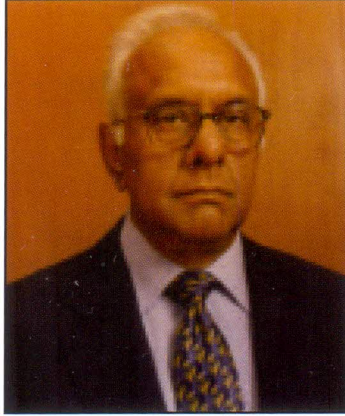

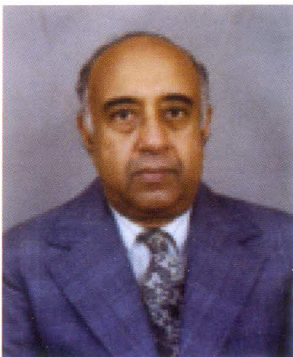

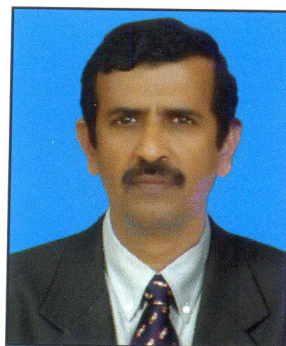

### **ANNUAL REPORT 2015-2016**

Distinguished Chief Guest Prof. Dr. K. Baskar, Vice-Chancellor of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli, Respected Secretary of the College Dr. G. Devarajan, Learned Colleagues, Beloved Students, Ladies and Gentlemen, I am presenting the 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual Report of this prestigious Institution to this august gathering with great delight and pleasure.

The vision and mission of this great institution guide us to serve the underprivileged people of the society in and around Alwarkurichi.

#### **Admissions**

Single window Admission to all Undergraduate Courses started with the number of applications received exceeding 2,300 and the admissions were completed during the last week of May 2015, followed by the re-opening of the College on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2015. All the seats were filled up in the existing courses and there was a good demand for PG admissions also during the month of July 2015 and the final figures of admissions were 468 in UG and 115 in PG. The present student strength of the College is 1576 out of which 676 are boys and 900 are girls.

#### **Staff**

The total strength of the teaching staff is 28 in aided stream and that of the non-teaching is 23. The total number of teaching staff is 34 in unaided stream and that of the non-teaching is 15. Our Management is gracious enough to fill the existing unfilled vacancies by appointing Adhoc Lecturers keeping in mind, the interest of the Students. The total number of Teaching Staff and the Non-teaching Staff duly appointed by the Management is 20 and 7 respectively. Dr. S. Sheik Saleem, Head, Department of Physics and Mrs. R. Pitchammal, Faculty of Tamil Department got retired from service on May 31<sup>st</sup> 2015.



Mr. B. Santosh Kumar, Assistant Professor of Physics and Mrs. S. Gandhimathi, Assistant Professor of Chemistry were relieved to pursue Ph.D. under Faculty Development Programme of the UGC.

## **Results**

Ms. P. Pooja of M.Sc. Microbiology and Ms. Chidambara Priyadharshini of B.Sc. Biotechnology obtained Gold Medal by securing First Rank in the University Examinations and a total of 23 students of our College secured various ranks at the University level. The results of students who appeared in November 2015 and April 2016 Examinations conducted by the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli are analysed and found to be good.

## **Student support**

Scholarships from the Government of Tamilnadu have been issued to BC and SC/ST students. Totally 128 and 195 students were benefitted under these categories. The numbers of beneficiaries for Management Scholarships for academic excellence this year, are 116 in UG and 4 in PG in aided stream and 47 in UG and 13 in PG in unaided stream. Alumni Association of our College also provides Scholarships for deserving students every year.

To motivate the students in Sports Activity, this year, our Management has given Scholarship for achievers in University Level. Mr Padmanabhan of III B.Sc. Mathematics won Silver Medal in 5000 Mtrs and 10000 Mtrs race and he has been awarded a cash prize of Rs. 6000/-. Mr.Sailappan of III B.Com. won Silver Medal in Weight Lifting (69 kg Category) and awarded a cash prize of Rs. 3000/- and Ms. Sumithra of III B.Com. won Bronze Medal in Weight Lifting (53 Kg Category) and awarded a cash prize of Rs.2000/-.

## **Women's Day, Graduation Day and Sports Day**

Women's Day was celebrated in our College on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2016. Dr. C. Vijayambika, Principal, Rani Anna Government College for Women, Tirunelveli was invited as the Chief Guest. She spoke about the Role of Women in the Society and distributed the Prizes to the winners of various competitions.

The Graduation Day of the College was conducted on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2016 at Smt. Valli Anantharamakrishnan Hall. Dr. A.K. Kumaraguru, Former Vice-Chancellor of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli was the Chief Guest. He delivered the Key Note Address and distributed the Diplomas to the young Graduates. Out of 442 candidates passed out, 407 received their Certificates in person.

The Annual Sports Day was celebrated on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2016. Dr. S. Sethu, Assistant Professor and Head i/c, Department of Physical Education and Sports, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli presided over the function and distributed the prizes to the Students.

I appreciate their noble gesture of dedicating this institution for inculcating values in students such as perseverance, integrity, and discipline without compromising on freedom. Dear Friends, if we pause for a moment to look at the statistics on education in Tamil Nadu, it is one of the most literate states in India. The state's literacy rate is 80.33% as of 2011, which is above the national average. A survey conducted by the Industry body ASSOCHAM (Associated Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India) ranks Tamil Nadu in the top among the Indian States with about 100% Gross Enrollment Ratio (GER) in primary and upper primary education. The present status of Gross Enrollment Ratio in Higher Education in Tamil Nadu is 42% which is way above the national average.

My dear young graduates, you are at a time in your life that you feel proud to have achieved something great from this institution. I know that you owe your parents who paid for your studies. This is indeed an opportunity to

feel happy, in your mutual accomplishment. Many of you may have to exit the portals of higher learning i.e., further studies, and face the challenges of life. It may look like the calm before the storm. For those of you, it is time to remind yourselves of the 'Thirukkural' couplet which says:

Of course, here ends your father's/parents' duty of giving you good and quality education that has placed you amongst the learned people in the society.

In reciprocation, what should you do to your parents? What is expected of you is again given by 'Thiruvalluvar' in another couplet in 'Thirukkural':

This means, you have to not only secure a good job, but also take care of your parents and become good citizens of this country and make your parents proud.

Young Friends,

In Tamil Nadu, the fundamentals for Higher Learning activities have already been set by the declaration of the Tamil Nadu Government's "Vision-2023" document, wherein, among other things, the vision clearly aims to achieve universal secondary education and more than 50% enrolment in higher education (comprising of vocational and college education). Further, this



document clearly focuses its attention on the magnitude of the skill development process, in order to kick-start the socio-economic engines. Vision-2023 clearly states that, Tamil Nadu's skill development dream is to confer basic skills to the persons numbering approximately 10 million as of 2013 and increase it by about 8 lakhs each year, through the year 2023. In addition to this, about 5 million people who are already in the workforce would be subjected to re-skilling (upgrading of skills). These "minimal" skills would be aimed at making the persons concerned suitable for the large number of entry level jobs in various sectors and industries that will open up as the economy grows at high rates. As a Graduate today, you are about to join and shine in this assemblage.

At this juncture, I would like to lay emphasis on the need for basic science education for our people:

Science, Science teaching, Research and Universities have been with us for centuries and remain largely unchanged in their main aims from when they were started. Our rich culture has had 'Nalanda University' and places of higher learning in our State of Tamil Nadu. From our History, we can infer that, more than 2700 years back, huge universities existed in ancient India, where over 10,500 students from all across the world came for higher studies. This was the 'Takshashila' University of Ancient India. During its times, this university was the modern equivalent of an IIT and MIT, of the yester-world. In such universities, students from all across the world, came to attain specialization in over 64 different fields of study like Vedhas, Grammar, Philosophy, Ayurvedha, Agriculture, Surgery, Politics, Archery, Warfare, Astronomy, Commerce, Futurology, Music, Dance, etc. There were even curious subjects like the art of discovering hidden treasures and decrypting encrypted messages.

Ancient India was a land of sages, saints, and seers as well as a land of scholars and scientists. Ancient India's contribution to science and technology includes a variety of subjects:

Mathematics - Vedhic literature is replete with concepts of zero, the techniques of algebra and algorithm, square root and cube root. The origins of Calculus lie in India 300 years before Leibnitz and Newton. Astronomy - As early as 2000 BC Rig Vedha refers to astronomy.

Physics - Concepts of atom and theory of relativity were explicitly stated by an Indian Philosopher around 600 BC, and also by *Thirumoolar* in *Thirumandhiram* in Tamil.

Chemistry - Principles of chemistry did not remain abstract, but also found expression in distillation of perfumes, aromatic liquids, manufacturing of dyes and pigments, and extraction of sugar, and metallurgy resulting in *Panchalokam* (meaning combination of 5 metals), with which the Idols were made for worship in temples.

Medical Science & Surgery - Around 800 BC, the first compendium on medicine and surgery was compiled in the ancient India.

Fine Arts - Vedhas were recited and recitation has to be correct, which gave rise to a finer study of sound and phonetics. The natural corollary was emergence of music and other forms of performing arts.

Mechanical & Production Technology - Greek historians have testified to smelting of certain metals in India in the 4th century BC.

Civil Engineering & Architecture - The discovery of urban settlements of *Mohenjodaro* and *Harappa* indicate existence of civil engineering & architecture, which blossomed to a highly precise science of civil engineering and architecture and found expression in innumerable monuments of ancient India.

Shipbuilding & Navigation - Sanskrit and Bali texts have several references to maritime activity by ancient Indians.

Sports & Games - Ancient India is the birth place of Chess, Snakes and Ladders, and Playing Cards.

My dear young friends,

There is a wrong notion among the young generation of today that one could get a well-paid job only if one becomes an Engineer or Technologist or Medical Doctor or a Management specialist. It is not true. Science can be an attractive option, because all the comforts and conveniences enjoyed by us are based on science. There can be no technology without science. As a qualified Engineer one may expect to have a well-paid job in the field of Technology. But there will be intense competition, out there in the open market place, and many



may find it difficult to secure a place the way they expected. However, there are other avenues open. One such avenue is a career in Science. There are plenty of opportunities available. Therefore you need not hesitate to pursue science as a career.

**Science knows no country, because knowledge belongs to humanity and it is the torch which illuminates the world.**

- Louis Pasteur

In order to encourage Science, the Department of Science and Technology of the Ministry of Science and Technology has come up with an attractive scheme called INSPIRE.

INSPIRE is the acronym for Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research (INSPIRE). It is an innovative programme sponsored and managed by the Department of Science & Technology for attracting young talents to Science. The basic objective of INSPIRE is to communicate to the youth of the country the excitements of creative pursuit of science, attract talent to the study of science at an early age and thus build the required critical human resource pool for strengthening and expanding the Science & Technology system and R&D base.

A striking feature of the programme is that it does not believe in conducting competitive examinations for identification of talent at any level. It believes in and relies on the efficacy of the existing educational structure for identification of talent. INSPIRE fellowships and scholarships are available.

INSPIRE fellowship scheme is applicable to Basic sciences and Applied sciences. Here is an opportunity for those of you who have the research bent of mind to pursue a post graduate degree and climb the ladder of Scientific career. In order to face the intense competition out there in the open, some of you should think differently and try the different options available instead of blaming the system and the administration. There is a common saying among the educated, and that is:

**Winners don't do different things to be Winners;  
They just do things differently.**

One of the prime duties of our education system is to inculcate good moral values and ethics among our students and promote these among our faculty and staff members.

**Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya**, a famous Indian educationist, founder of the Banaras Hindu University, and freedom fighter notable for his role in the Indian independence movement, once said about the Institutions of higher learning as follows:

*"It (i.e., Institution) will seek not merely to turn out men as engineers, scientists, doctors, merchants, theologians but also as men of high character, probity and honor, whose conduct through life will show that they bear the hallmark of a great University."*

But, what is happening today, to our disbelief, is shocking!

Here is something that our teachers should take note of:

Swami Vivekananda says "The object of ideal system of education should be not only advancement of theoretical knowledge but also advancement of life, development of the highest powers and capacities, and the unfolding of the noblest potentialities of the student. The student must be enabled to apply all the ideas he has learnt and gathered and thus promote his (i.e., Student's) growth - physically, intellectually, morally and spiritually.

An educated person gets better opportunities in life. A society without education will become the breeding ground for violence, superstition, and intolerance. An educated society will promote tolerance and peace, justice and understanding, innovation and advancement, and positive self-sustaining growth. It is important to educate young persons, no matter where they live, for they will grow to become responsible citizens of the society. Each person represents a future, the future of the community and of the country.

What we see today, to our dismay and disbelief, are appalling violence in the name of caste and religion. We are not ashamed of corruption as it has become rampant and almost institutionalized. We see many of our students have become materialistic, ignoring social values and the principles and philosophy of life. Some have even gone to the extent of being rude and perverted in their minds that has led to even assassination of their own teachers and misbehavior towards their fellow students in immoral ways. What is the remedy? Our only hope is education; Of course, the right kind of education! Here is a challenge to our educators / teachers. Towards this, there is an urgent need to design suitable curricula which will mould our students as confident and responsible citizens.



My dear young graduates,

Today is an important day in your life and a significant milestone in your life's journey. Facing intense competition, you have entered in to the portals of this institution, and pursued your academic work with great dedication. With your hard work and dedication to maintain high standards, you have earned your degrees, awards, prizes and medals. No doubt, it is a moment of pride and joy for you. You can recall that your mission for higher learning began here with great passion. I am sure that it will not end here. It will not end until you feel fully confident of meeting uncertainties and challenges of the life's laboratory and dealing with successes and failures with a positive attitude.

To be a successful person in life, you may want to have, what I define as, a "3D" approach to your target. The 3 D's are: **1. Discipline 2. Determination and 3. Dedication.**

If you want to be successful in life, remember these three D's. The first "D", **Discipline** is such an important aspect of life that Thiruvalluvar says:

The third "D" is about achieving the target finally. For this you should have the **Dedication** to work for it. In the words of Kumaragurupara adigalaar it is, (Here, I shall read his poem for you):

Again this is what is said in Thirukkural as:

### **The Mysterious Triangle**

The Bermuda Triangle is located in the western region of the North of Atlantic Ocean. The triangle is also termed as Devil's Triangle, a name derived from the mysterious disappearance of people, ships and aircrafts under circumstances. Florida, Puerto Rico, Bermuda demarcate the vertices of Bermuda triangle, which spreads to less than one hundred miles on each side. The triangle has an area of about five hundred thousand square miles. The disappearance of the plane of the Flight Nineteen in December 1945, NC 16002 plane in December 1948, SS Marine Sulphur Queen in 1963 and USS Cyclops in 1918 are some example cases at this triangle. In all these cases of disappearances, the planes and ships had never been traced.

The scientist believed that the mystery is due to the natural circumstances such as weather, hydrological or geological explanations. There is evidence that at the triangle, there is an enormous explosion of methane gas. The scientist asserts that if a surface vessel gets caught inside a large methane gas, it loses its ability to float and submerge. If the bubbles are so gigantic, they may possess high gravitational pull that attracts the aircraft towards it, hence making it crash into the triangle. The ships and crafts may then ignite spontaneously and explode, produce little or no trace.

Thus, disappearance in the Bermuda triangle, far from being a footnote to the past history of the sea, are still continuing on the average of a plane about every two weeks and a ship or yacht almost weekly.
